

Jr Bass Pre-Tournament Checklist

1. Verify age eligibility rules for each Jr Angler to determine which age group a Jr Angler may compete in. See Rule #2 of Jr Bass Rules.
2. Pre-Register Jr Bass Teams and Boat Captains using the On-Line Registration Form.
3. Mail in Entry Fee to the Tournament Director. Tournament Director mailing address will be supplied thru the On-Line Registration Form.
4. Show up for the Team Registration at the Tournament Briefing Meeting. All Jr Anglers and Boats Captains must be present and\pr represented for the Team Registration.
5. Jr Anglers will be responsible for the bringing the following documentation to the Team Registration:
 - a. Completed and Signed Jr Angler Release Form.
 - b. Copy of Birth Certificate.
6. Boat Captains will be responsible for bringing the following documentation to the Team Registration:
 - a. Completed and Signed Jr Bass Boat Captain Release Form.
 - b. Copy of the documented \$300,000 Boating Liability Insurance policy.
7. All Jr Anglers and Boat Captains must be present at the Tournament Briefing Meeting. No Exceptions. This is when tournament rules will be reviewed and the Jr Anglers will be paired up and assigned to a Boat Captain.
8. Jr Anglers need to be sure to bring a proper fitting Life Preserver. The Life Preserver must be worn at ALL times by EVERYONE in the boat. This includes the Boat Captains. Jr Anglers must wear the jacket while they are fishing. No Exceptions. See Rule #5 of Jr Bass Rules.
9. Jr Anglers shall be responsible for their own fishing equipment, rods, reels, tackle, etc. See Rule #7 of Jr Bass Rules.
10. All Jr Anglers must be made aware of the Jr Bass Tournament Rules and agree to abide by the rules.
